





UNESCO Institute of Statistics (UIS) and the Global Education Monitoring Report (GEMR) have come up with its 2021 edition of the SDG 4 Data Digest, National SDG 4 Benchmarks: Fulfilling Our Neglected Commitment which presents SDG4 benchmark indicators and values to achieve SDG4 by 2030. It serves as a stark reminder to all the member countries about the importance of setting national education targets and of properly financing them, particularly in the face of the difficulties brought upon the sector by COVID-19.


**SDG4 Benchmark Indicators**



## Early Childhood Education Attendance





## Completion Rate





## Minimum Proficiency Level, Reading




■ Grades 2/3 ■ End of Primary ■ End of Lower Secondary

## Minimum Proficiency Level, Mathematics




