

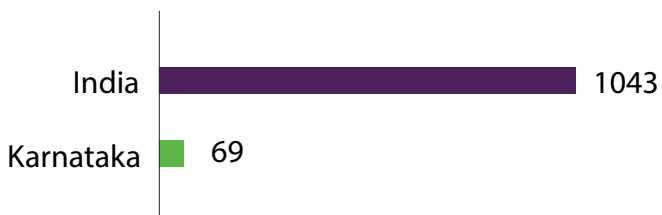

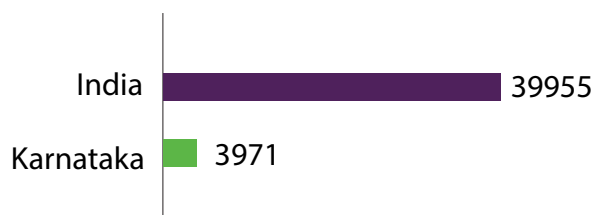

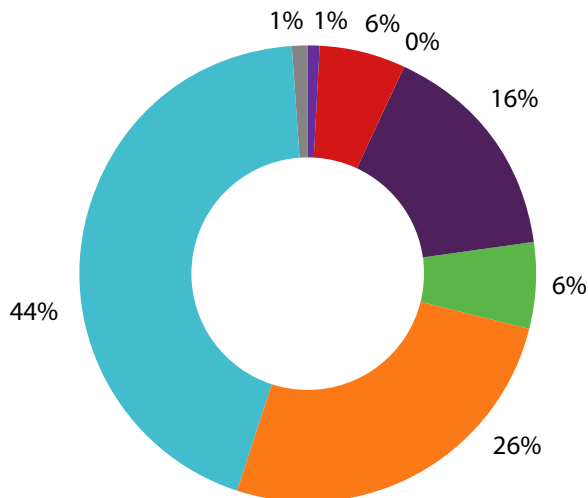
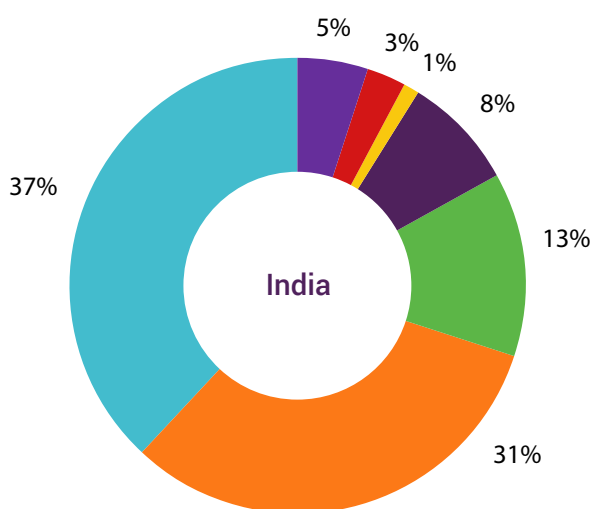
Number of Universities as of 2019-20

Universities in India and Karnataka as of 2019-20

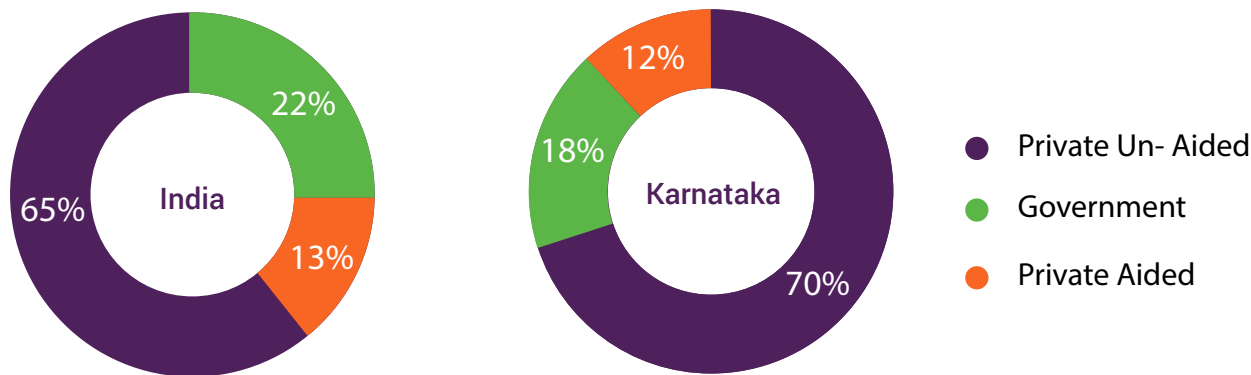

Only 2.7% Colleges run Ph.D. programme and 35.04% Colleges run Post Graduate Level programmes

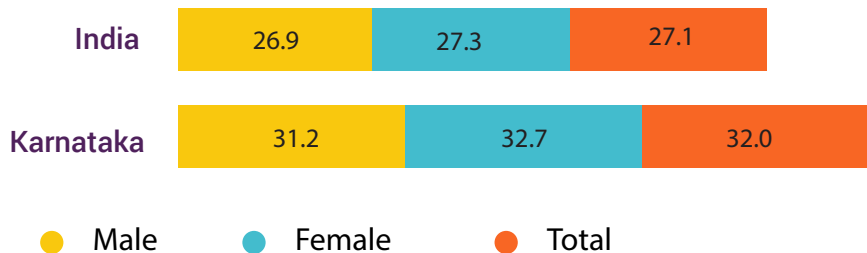
Number of Institutes of National Importance have increased from 75 in 2015 to 135 in 2020 (80% increase)
