

Highlights of UGC (Setting up and Operation of Campuses of Foreign Higher Educational Institutions in India) Regulations 2023

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has released the "University Grants Commission (Setting up and Operation of Campuses of Foreign Higher Educational Institutions in India) Regulations, 2023." The regulations are aligned with the vision of National Education Policy 2020 and aim to establish a robust regulatory framework for the entry and operation of FHEIs in India.

Key Highlights of the Regulations





Apply online to the commission along with non-refundable fee



Upload documents

- Permission by the governing body or board or by whatever name called
- Information on proposed location, infrastructure facilities, fee structure and financial resources
- Details of academic courses, courses, faculty and curricula
- Undertaking that the quality of education imparted is similar to that of the main campus
- Recognition and status to the degree awarded in India will be in par with the degree awarded in their home town
- Accreditation or quality assurance report from a recognized body



Constitution of a standing committee to examine the matters



Assessment of each application based on the merit including their potential to strengthen educational opportunities in India



Strengths, contributions, research capacities, professional recognition etc., will be considered to assess an already outstanding institution



Commission to grant in-principle approval and issue a letter of intent within 60 days of receiving the recommendations



FHEIs to establish campuses in India within two years from the date of approval



Commission may reserve the right to provide extension, if required



Standing committee to examine the readiness of the campus to commence academic programmes and shall give its recommendations



Commission to give approval within sixty days to commence the operation of the campus after considering the recommendations






Admission and Fee Structure

Domestic and international students can be admitted Fee structure should be transparent and reasonable and can be decided by FHEI Prospectus to be available in the website at least 60 days prior to the commencement of admissions

Full or partial merit-based or needbased scholarships to be provided from funds Tuition fee concessions can be provided for students who are Indian citizens
