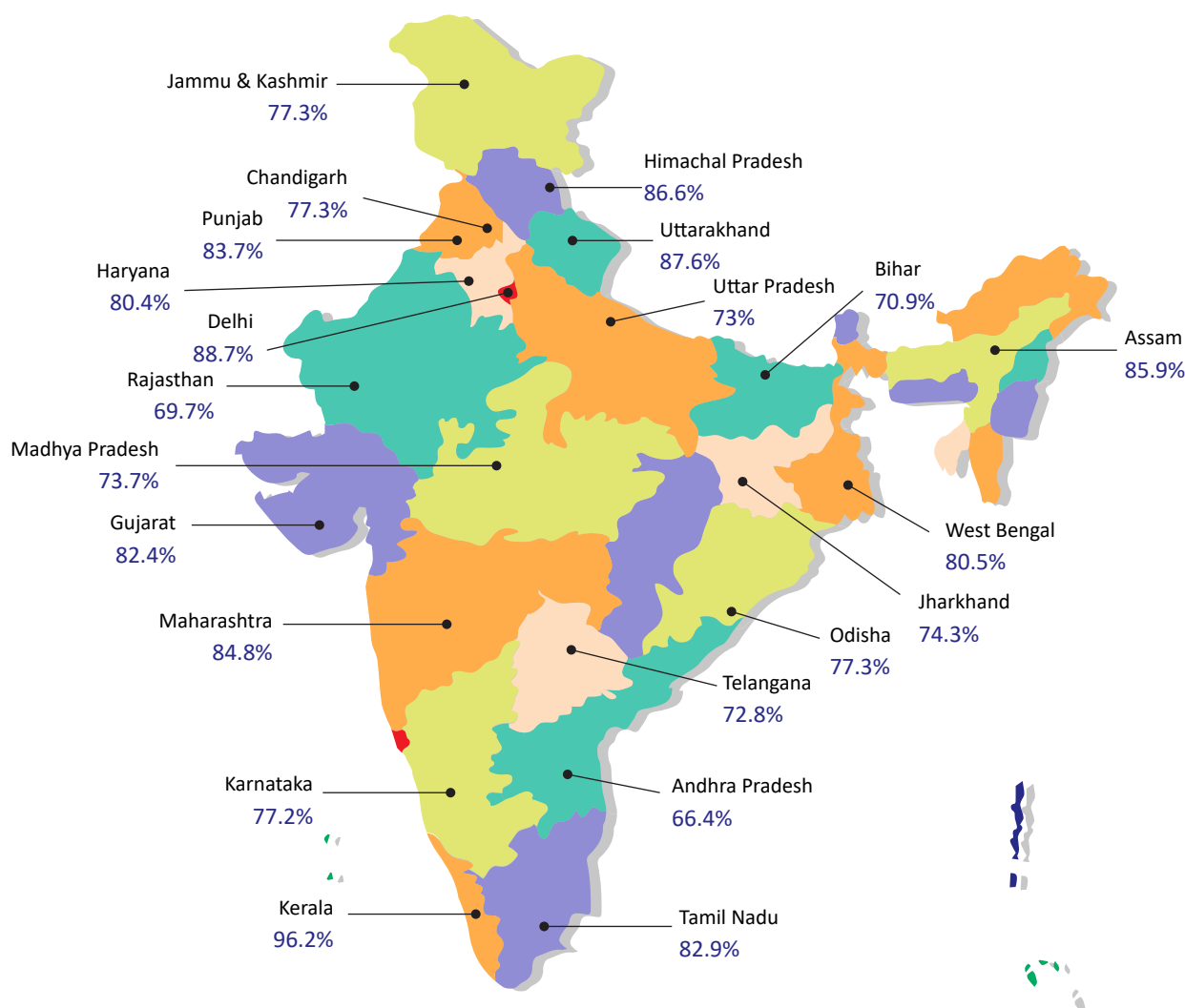


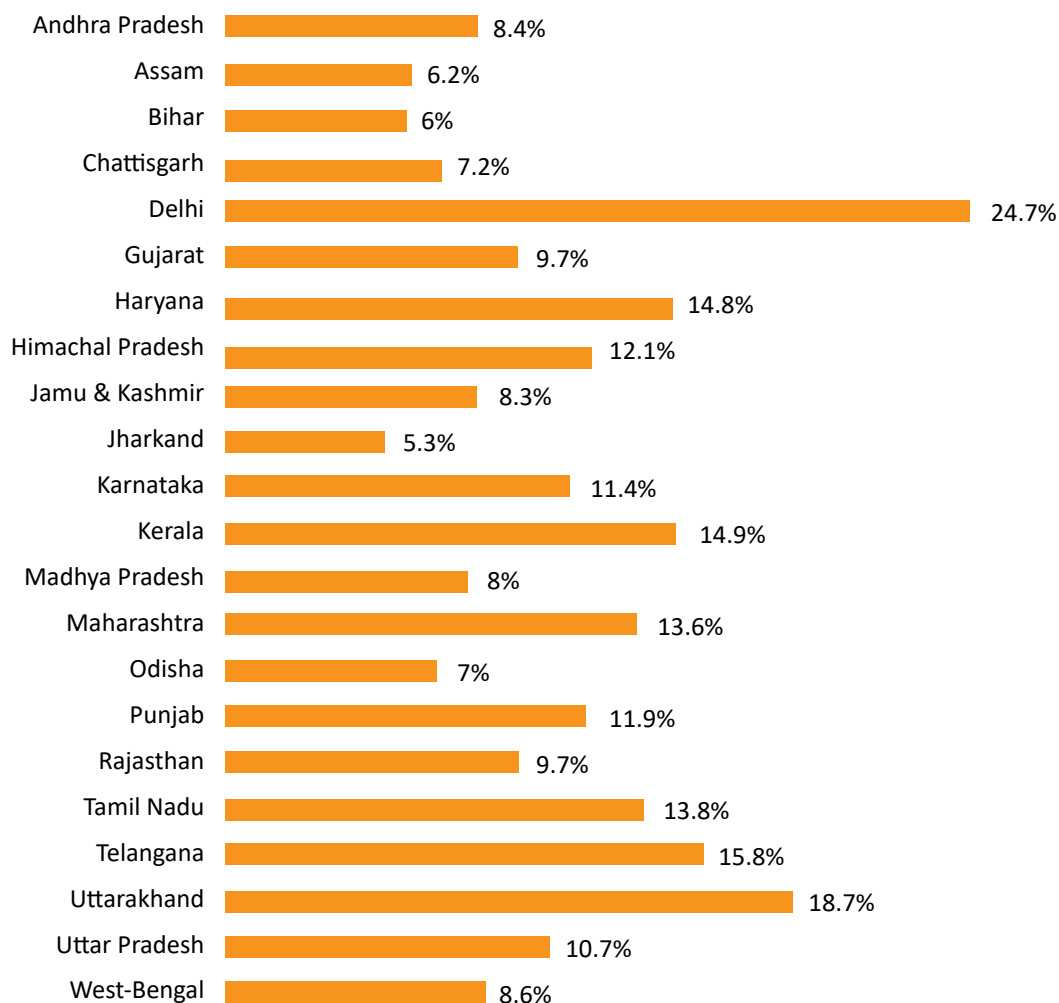
## Highlights of the NSS 75th round survey on Household Social Consumption on Education in India

CESS Infographic for October is based on the NSS 75th round survey on **Household Social Consumption on Education in India** conducted during July 2017-June 2018 by the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, National Statistics Office, Government of India. NSO's focus on Education for the 75th round was to build indicators on participation of the persons of age 3-35 years in the education system. This survey covered qualitative and quantitative aspects pertaining to educational attainment of the household members and educational services used by them. Highlighted here are State-wise Literacy rate; Percentage of graduates and above; and Digital Infrastructure with specific reference to Karnataka.

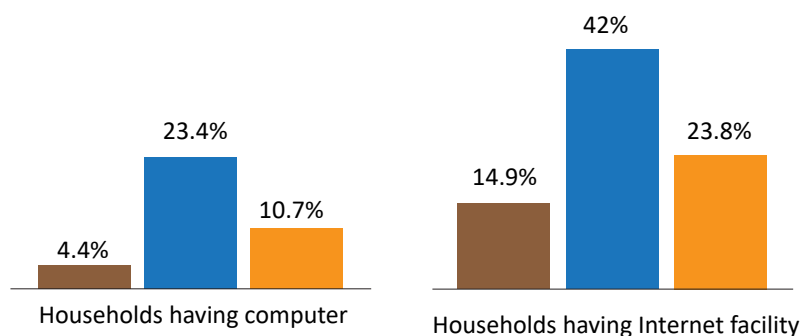

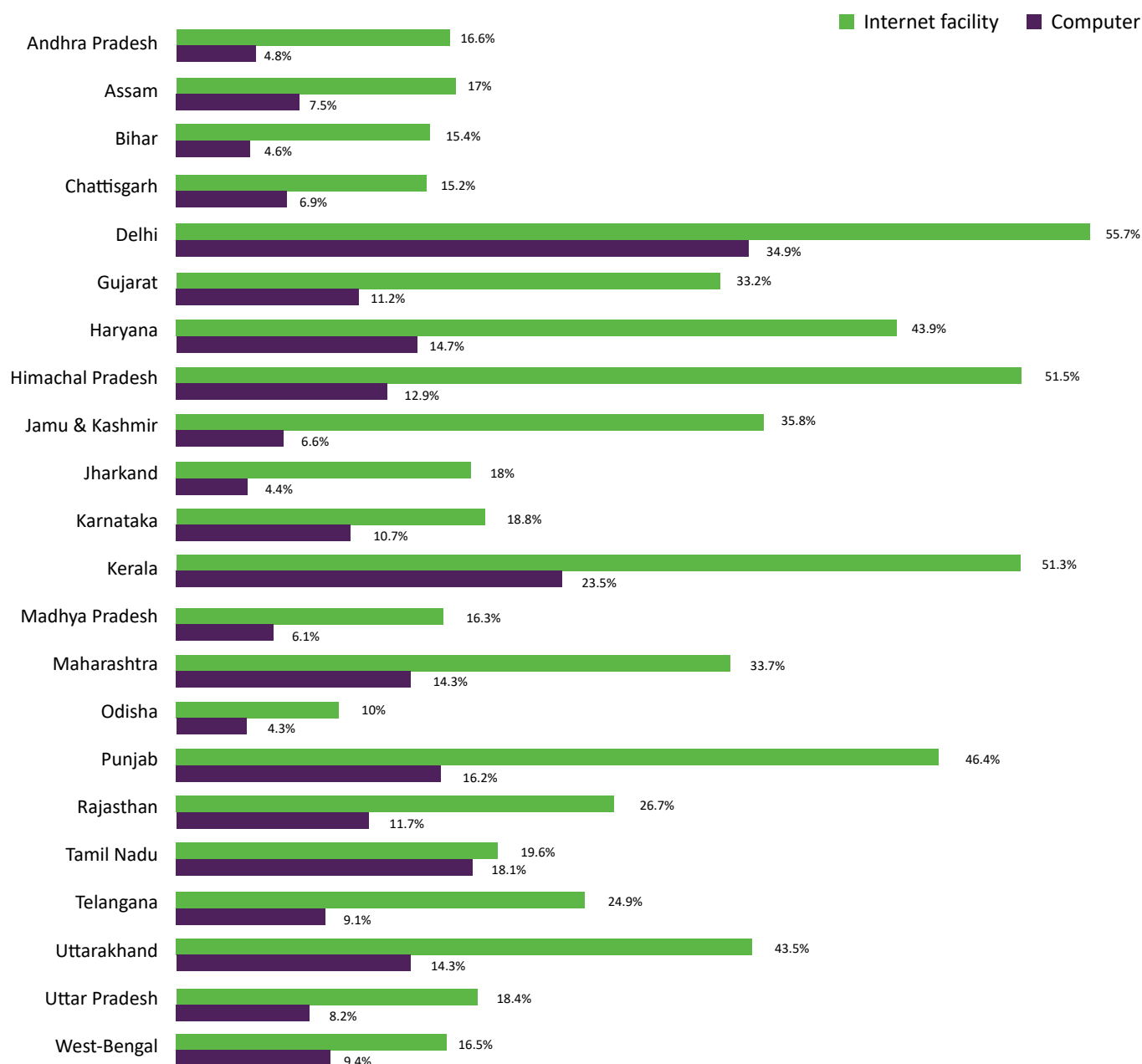
