Focused strategies to be made for attention on reducing the social category gaps and strengthening existing policies



Research to identify effective methods to encourage participation

What encourages children to come to school?

Special Education Zones (SEZs) to be declared



'Gender-Inclusion Fund' to provide equitable quality education for all girls and transgender students

Strengthening the infrastructure- Boarding facilities, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas and Kendriya Vidyalayas to be built



NEP will be in sync with Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPWD) Act 2016 with regard to Inclusive Education

Schools/school complexes to be provided resources for the integration of children with disabilities

All participants in the school education system will be sensitized to the requirements of **ALL** students

Teacher to identify learning disabilities and devise a plan for the same – **Learning system should play to a student's strengths**

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Higher Education

Develop and support high-quality HEIs that teach in local/Indian languages or bilingually



Mitigate opportunity costs and fees for pursuing higher education

Earmark suitable Government funds and Provide more financial assistance and scholarships

Make admissions processes and curriculum more inclusive

Enhance gender balance in admissions to HEIs



Increase employability potential of higher education programmes

Enhance access by establishing more high-quality HEIs in aspirational districts and SEZs

Develop **Institutional Development Plans** that contain specific plans for action on increasing participation from SEDGs

Conduct outreach programmes on higher education opportunities and scholarships



Provide socio-emotional and academic support and mentoring for all through counselling and mentoring programmes

Reduce digital divide - Increase technology literacy and usage



Technology Use and Integration

National Educational Technology Forum (NETF) will be created to provide a platform for free exchange of ideas on the use of technology



NETF to organize multiple regional and national conferences, workshops, etc to maintain regular inflow of data

NETF to categorize **emergent technologies** based on their potential and timeframe for disruption, and to present this analysis to MHRD



HEIs to conduct research, offer multidisciplinary courses, offer trainings and online courses



Schooling system to assist in **raising public awareness** – focus on discussion on ethical issues

Education software will be developed and made available for teachers and students

DIKSHA/SWAYAM platform to offer e-content in all regional languages. NCERT, CIET, CBSE, NIOS, other institutions to contribute for content



Equipment will be made available to teachers at schools to integrate e-content
