### **Highlights of AISHE Report 2020-21**

The Union Ministry of Education released the All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) Report for the year 2020-2021. The survey was launched on December 01, 2021 and continued till 30th April 2022. As the web DCF has been used for the first-time, large-scale scrutiny on various parameters such as enrolment (gender-wise, social category-wise, foreign students, NCC, NSS etc), teaching/nonteaching staff, pass out /outer etc., has been conducted.







### Type Wise Number of Responded Universities




#### No. of Respondent Stand-alone Institutions




61.39% Colleges are located in Rural Area. 10.51% Colleges are exclusively for Girls

#### **Out-turn/Pass-out at Different Levels**




Pupil Teacher Ratio (PTR) in Universities and Colleges is 24 in Regular mode

#### **State-wise Number of Universities**




### Number of Universities in last 5 years



# Estimated Increase/Decrease in the Enrolment of Students to Ph.D. & M.Phil during Five Years




# Estimated Increase/Decrease in the Enrolment of Students to PG and UG during Five Years




# Estimated Increase/Decrease in the Enrolment of Students to PGDM and Diploma during Five years





## Estimated Increase/Decrease in the Enrolment of Students to Certificate or Integrated Courses during Five Years




### **Gross Enrolment Ration during Last Five Years**
