# Highlights of Foundational Learning Study Report 2022

The Central Ministry of Education launched the National Initiative for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy (NIPUN) Bharat in July 2021. As a crucial step towards strengthening Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN), a large-scale Foundational Learning Study (FLS) was undertaken by National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) in March 2022. FLS 2022 is the largest study that assessed the learning levels of more than 86,000 Grade 3 students who are studying across India and is the only study that has been conducted in 20 different languages including Kannada.






State & National Avg. Performance (Foundational Literacy)

## **Oral Language Comprehension (%)**




Listens and comprehends four to five texts of varying lengths correctly

## Subtasks Assessed in Foundational Numeracy (%)
















## Benchmark of ORF with Comprehension and Student Performance (%)
