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A Glimpse of NEP Implementation Initiatives for School Education in India

The NEP 2020 envisions transforming India's education with an inclusive, equitable and flexible framework, emphasizing universal access, learner-centric approaches, multidisciplinary education and technology integration. Specific to school education, the policy proposes reforms in curriculum, early childhood care, foundational literacy, numeracy and experiential learning to foster critical thinking, creativity and problem-solving skills. The Ministry of Education, Govt. of India is implementing various NEP initiatives in both school and higher education. This infographic highlights key efforts aligned with NEP's goals for school education.

12 Swayam Prabha TV Channels

Under One class, One TV channel initiative (meant to support and reach those who do not have access to the internet) have been extended to 200 channels with more than 13,000 contents produced to telecast in 31 languages

Radio/Community Radio broadcasting/ Mobile Podcast

With 4000+ pieces of curriculum-based radio programs (Classes 1 to 12) broadcasted on 398 Radio Stations (11 GyanVani FM Radio Stations, 255 Community Radio Stations and 132 All India Radio stations)

Digital Infrastructure for Knowledge Sharing

One Nation One Digital Platform for Education - A storehouse of e-Books and e-Contents with over 3.17 lakh e-contents, 6,600 Energized Textbooks in 36 Languages (29 Indian languages and 7 Foreign Languages). All states /UTs have been onboarded in DIKSHA.

For Children with Special Needs

4200+ Indian Sign language (ISL) based contents, talking books (in Daisy format) and 3860+ Audio Books have been developed. All 10,000 ISL dictionary words have been uploaded on DIKSHA

Holistic Progress Card

The '360-degree Holistic Progress Card' was piloted in all States and UTs and also in the KVs and NVs. The HPC for the Foundational and Preparatory stages is finalized for implementing from 2023-24 and for the Middle and Secondary stages is in progress.

National Initiative for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy (NIPUN Bharat)

- 3062 Schools have been upgraded
- 235 Residential schools and hostels have been opened
- 97364 schools strengthened
- 122757 Schools covered under ICT & Digital initiatives
- 8619 schools covered under Vocational Education
- 351 KGBVs upgraded from class 8 to 10
- 2264 KGBVs upgraded from class 8 to 12
- ICT Labs approved in 135740 schools & Smart Classrooms in 103662 schools

National Digital Education Architecture (NDEAR)

- NDEAR has witnessed 1500+ Micro courses, 5 billion+ Learning sessions, 12 billion+ QR codes, 20K+ Ecosystem participants, and 15K+ Micro improvements ongoing across the various linked building blocks.

National Professional Standards for Teachers

- Pilot study of NPST conducted covering 75 central govt schools (25 KVs, 25 JNVs, and 25 CBSE schools)

Vidya Pravesha

- 36 States/UTs have implemented VidyaPravesh
- 1,80,13,930 students from 8,77,793 schools participated across States/UTs.

Vidyanjali

- 6,84,147 schools have been onboarded
- 4,46,898 volunteers have registered
- Impacted 6077832 students
- A series of orientation sessions/review meetings have been organized
- Introduced a CSR module for participation.
- Around 2926 CSR/NGOs have been registered

Piloted in 30 central govt schools. 60 mentors have been onboarded & the web portal is made operational for conducting mentoring sessions. The Bluebook on NMM finalized after incorporating the feedback /suggestions

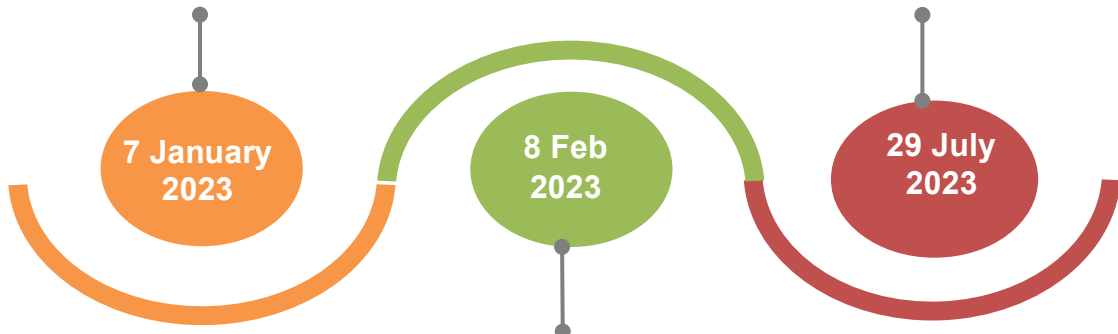
6448 schools across 30 State/UTs/Institutions (KVs & NVs) have been covered in the first phase

Aspirational Districts/ Blocks

- 11 Key Performance Indicators (KPI) have been identified to monitor the progress in school education
- 'Sankalp Saptaah' was organised in schools covering all 500 ABP Blocks from 3rd to 9th October 2023
- 100 least developed Aspirational Blocks were finalised on the basis of identified KPIs and the same was shared with NITI Aayog

ULLAS

- Implemented in hybrid (Both in online and offline) mode through volunteerism.
- Students from 7 lakh schools registered (under UDISE, Higher Education Institutions under UGC and Teacher Education Institutions under NCTE) for Volunteers
- Volunteers of NYSK, NSS and NCC will also be involved



PARAKH

- Strengthening Assessment Cells established in more than 26 States and UTs
- Equivalence of School Boards – First national level consultative meeting held with 9 School Education Boards
- A series of 5-day regional workshops of the Education Board across the five regions were conducted



National Curriculum Framework for School Education (NCF-SE)

The curriculum has been aligned with the National Education Policy 2020, emphasizing the 5+3+3+4 design of schooling

National Vidya Samiksha Kendra

The NVSK integrated with their state counterparts. Currently enabled visibility, insights and actionability across 11 programs. NISHTHA extended to cover teachers

DIETs of Excellence

The scheme will start approximately with 120 DIETs in FY 2023-24
